RULES FOR THE MEDITERRANEAN CUP

Art. 1 – AIMS

- 1.1 The activity concerning the organisation and the planning of the event, as well the coordination of the participating countries is managed by the FIDASC (Italian Federation of the Disciplines Hunting Sportive Weapons) Federation recognised by C.O.N.I. (Italian National Olympic Committee) in accordance with the FEDECAT (Federaciones Deportivas de Caza y Tiro) , with the goal to promote and to emphasize the use of the pointers by the sports dog-fancier in a big international competition.

Art. 2 - GENERAL RULES

- 2.1 The general rules are those of the international Official Rules of the “Field Trials” (F.C.I. “– Fédération Cynologique Internationale) for British and continental pointers.
2.2 The competition allows of two Autumn International Practical Hunting Quest Game on natural game without shooting.
2.3 The “Field Trials” are run in pairs (braces)

Art. 3 - ORGANISATION

- 3.1 FIDASC and FEDECAT delegate the organisation to the Organising Committee created in the country that hosts the event.
3.2 All the necessary initiatives to the good completion of the event will be entrusted to the Organising Committee will entrust.
3.3 The Organising Committee will elect, its own President and its Secretary.

Art. 4 – PARTICIPATION

- 4.1 All the sports dog- fanciers of the Mediterranean countries and all those who make specific request can take part in the competition.
4.2 Every country is allowed to enter only one team for British pointers and one team for Continental pointers.
4.3 Every team should be composed by a minimum of 2 handlers with 2 dogs and a maximum of 4 handlers with 4 dogs. A substitute dog can be appointed , provided that it has been previously notified according to the terms of the present regulations.
4.4 The dog must have the same nationality of his owner. Only dogs and sporting dog-fanciers who have hold the nationality of the country they will be presenting for at least six months month by the date of the start of the competition of the Mediterranean Cup have from at least 6 months the nationality of the country they represent will be admitted in a national team.
4.5 The teams who will take part in the Mediterranean Cup will be represented by a team leader appointed directly by their country.

Art. 5 - ENTRY FEES

- 5.1 The entry fees of the teams (including the substitute dog) must reach the Organizing Committee of the host country at least 15 days before the beginning of the event.
5.2 The entries will only be valid if they are accompanied by the:
a) name, breed , sex of dog;
b) stud book registration number;
c) tattoo number or microchip;
d) number of the working record book;
e) name and addresses of the breeder, the owner and the handler.
5.3 The amount of the entry fee per competitor, to pay before the start of the contest, is established by the Organizing Committee, after the final approbation by the FIDASC and the FEDECAT.

Art. 6 - RUN OF THE COMPETITIONS

- 6.1 The carrying out the contest is foreseen in two days.
6.2 In the competitions can participate the categories, Individual and Teams, for British and Continental Pointers dogs.
6.3 The competitions will be carried out in pairs.
6.4 Each contest lasts 15 minutes.
6.5 The drawing of lots to establish braces (pairs) and their running order will be done the eve of each trial in the evening. Drawing will be managed by the delegate of the Organizing Committee,
6.6 A same sports dog-fancier may be present only in one series of the two competitions.
6.7 For each category of admitted breeds, the awarding of the highest qualification is foreseen in each day of the competition.

Art. 7 – JUDGES

- 7.1 The formation of the jury will be proposed by the Organizing Committee to the FIDASC and FEDECAT.
7.2 The jury will be made up of 2 judges of different nationality, of which one will be act as president.
7.3 Each series will have 2 judges, the eventual barrage contest will have 3 judges.
7.4 The Organizing Committee will make sure the presidents of the different juries have different nationality.
7.5 The provenance nations will take care of the journey expenses of the judges.
7.6 The Organizing Committee will take care of the meals and accommodation expenses of the judges.

Art. 8 – GAME

- 8.1 The trials will be run on natural game without shooting.

Art. 9 – JUDGING AND CLASSIFICATION

- 9.1 The judges should let every brace (pairs) work for 15 minutes, even in case of an eliminating fault of one of the dog in the brace. In this case, the rest of the round will be run “for the honour” of the eliminated dog but, previously, the president of the jury must inform the handler of the eliminated dog. However, all dogs proving to be insufficient in pace of the quest , or interfering with their brace mate will be stopped.

- 9.2 To establish an order for the titles , points will be assigned to the awarded dogs according to the classifications achieved during the two days and following the quotations below:

CACIT	= 12 points
R.CACIT	= 11 points
CAC	= 10 points
R.CAC	= 9 points
1st Excellent	= 8 points
Excellent/from 2°nd	= 7 points
Very Good	= 4 points
Good	= 2 points

- 9.3 The notes for the categories Individual and for Teams are not cumulative
- 9.4 The classification for a team is determined by the total of points obtained by the same team members over the two days of the contest, in accordance with the above quotations stated in the art.9 clause 2.
- 9.5 A team must have at least two dogs classified to appear in the list of the prices.
- 9.6 In case of equality of points, the highest number of classified dogs in each team will be taken into consideration, in case of other equality, the team that will get more points with the dog.
- 9.7 The team ranking "first" is declared "Champion Team of the Mediterranean Cup for the year in course" for practical hunting pointers on natural game without shooting.
- 9.8 The team ranking "second" is declared " Vice-Champion Team of the Mediterranean Cup for the year in course" for practical hunting pointers on natural game without shooting.
- 9.9 The team ranking "third" is declared " 3^ Champion Team of the Mediterranean Cup for the year in course" for practical hunting pointers on natural game without shooting.
- 9.10 The classification for the individual titles is determined by the total of points obtained by each dog over the two days of contest, in accordance with the quotations stated in the art.9 clause 2.
- 9.11 A dog must have, at least, an "Excellent" to be eligible for a title and must have run the two days of the contest.
- 9.12 In case of equality of points, a barrage will take place for the assignment of the 1°st – 2°nd and 3°rd classified.
- 9.13 If it is not possible to do the eventual barrages, the classifications order will be determined giving more points to the younger handler.
- 9.14 The sporting dog-fancier who with his dog standing first is declared "Champion of the Mediterranean Cup " for practical hunting pointers on natural game without shooting for the year in course
- 9.15 The sporting dog-fancier who with his dog ranked second is declared "Vice-Champion of the Mediterranean Cup" for practical hunting pointers on natural game without shooting for the year in course.
- 9.16 The sporting dog-fancier who with his dog ranking third is declared "ranked 3° of the Mediterranean Cup" for practical hunting pointers on natural game without shooting for the year in course.

Art. 10 – PRIZES

- 10.1 The prizes are at the expenses of the FIDASC.

Art. 11 – EXCLUSIONS

- 11.1 Sports dog-fanciers and their dogs that do not fulfil all the requirements of article 1.1 clauses 1-2-3 can not take part in the competition,
- 11.2 Bitches in heat, aggressive dogs and those with a contagious disease will be excluded from the competitions.

Art. 12 – COMPLAINTS

- 12.1 There is no appeal against the judgements and assessments of the jury.
- 12.2 In the event of disputes, the eventual complaints will be settled on the ground by the Delegate appointed by the FIDASC and by the FEDECAT.

Art. 13 - THE PUBLIC

- 13.1 The public attending the event must behave correctly, without disturbing the running of the competition and without openly expressing judgement. The public must at all times comply with the instructions of the organisers. Those who transgress will be removed from the competition grounds.

Art. 14 – CANCELLATION OF THE COMPETITION

- 14.1 In exceptional case of natural calamity or of impediment of force majeure the competition will be cancelled.

Art. 15 – FINAL PROVISION

- 15.1 For what is not explicitly foreseen in these Rules, the International Rules for Pointers on natural game – F.C.I. (Règlement International pour chiens d'arrêt sur gibier naturel FCI) are valid.

Art. 16 – TRANSITORY PROVISIONS

- 16.1 The FIDASC and the FEDECAT will provide to constitute and regulate a standing International Organising Committee composed by the representatives of the adherent countries. This Committee will be charged to supervise and to settle every provision concerning the event.
