

COUNTRY SHOOTING WITH RIFLE

A “Complete” event which sounds real hunting!



The institutional aim of the Federation, which is caring and spreading its disciplines using hunting weapons, has a new ambitious target: transferring on a purely competition ground (something that has been done by other sports) the emotion of a real hunting shooting event performed in the most “natural” conditions

ever, without the exasperated technical and regulatory mechanisms, typical of target shooting. Just like it occurs in equestrian sports since longtime, Country Shooting gains a new all-round event, which, as the technical regulation, published in full in the official website, shows more in detail and as it is briefly reported in this leaflet, includes three different events: 50 m running boar; four 100 meter targets in different positions and 200 meter fixed chamois with support.




With no sophisticated weapons, from the technical and aesthetic point of view, the athlete will challenge him/herself with different types of shooting, and his/her preparation will be harshly tested in a real complex and “complete” test stand .

DEVELOPMENT OF THE COMPETITION

The competition will take place in two days:

- 1st day :50 meter on running boar and 200 m on the fixed chamois
- 2nd day: 100 m. on 4 fixed, deer, sitting fox, chamois and boar targets

Each shooter will perform two rounds per specialty event; The shooter shall present at the firing line with headphones or similar hearing protection devices and protection eyeglasses , with the rifle in perfect functioning conditions and suitable ammunitions. All shooters are forbidden to bring with them more cartridges than those strictly needed to end the competition.



Allowed ammunitions and sights those mentioned in the regulations of each specialty events of country shooting from 100 and 200 meters with the exception of 50 m. running boar shooting where the use of scopes with or without sight and/or rangefinders is allowed .

Specialty event: 50 m running boar:

The competition will be run over 2 rounds of four shots each: 2 shots are fired at the target from left to right and 2 shots from right to left. The sequence of the shots is decided by the shooter. Once at the stand, the shooter, upon command of the Competition Judge who must be there, proceeds to load the rifle with one allowed cartridge;

The running boar will be shot from a distance of 45 to 50 meters, from left to right and from right to left alternatively in a shooting window of 10 meters.

The speed will be regulated to make it possible to see the target for about 2.5 seconds both from left to right and from right to left. The shooter waiting for the target may shoulder the weapon after calling the target without waiting for it to show. All shots will be fired from the respective stands.




Specialty event: Four 100 m targets:

The competition takes place over two rounds of 16 shots each. Each round includes:

- 4 shots at the DEER: the shooter will stand with the rifle resting on a pole set aside the stand, having a diameter of 8/15 cm , and the two ends fixed (ground/ceiling);
- 4 shots at the SITTING FOX: the shooter will lie down in the prone position, his arms will support the front part of the rifle resting only on the elbows;

n. 4 shots at the CHAMOIS: the shooter may stand with the rifle resting on an alpenstock having a diameter of 25/30 mm and 2 m high, fixed to the ground;

n. 4 shots on the BOAR: the shooter will stand with no support at all. All shots will be fired from the shooters' respective stands from a distance of 100 meters. The academic shot is allowed.



Depending on the installations, the first trial will be performed on the deer, the second on the sitting fox, the third on the chamois and the fourth on the boar, and so on for all the participants who will keep rotating by occupying the different stands. In full respect of the target sequence, when it is possible, it is allowed to place them not to have the same target for all shooters.

Specialty event: 200 m chamois

The competition takes place in two rounds of four shots each. Each round must be ended in 8 minutes maximum. The chamois will be shot from 200 m with support provided by the organization .

All shots will be fired from each one's stand.

RANKINGS

Final rankings will be drawn up for the different categories and specialty events. An additional ranking will also be drawn up by adding up the scores obtained in the three different specialty events to award the First “Complete” EUROPEAN CUP.

RULES OF BEHAVIOUR

Shooters participating in the competition are strictly forbidden to interfere with and/or influence in any way, during and after the competition, the work of FIDASC Delegate and the Judges' .

In case of irregular behavior, the shooter is immediately disqualified and accompanied out of the shooting ground by the Judge who will immediately inform the Jury

ENTRY FEES

€ 25,00 per specialty event in which one wishes to participate

COMPLAINTS

Complaints must be submitted in written form before reading the official rankings, after paying a caution money of 50 Euros, which will be refunded only in case the claim will be admitted by FIDASC Delegate . If not refunded, the above sum of 50 Euros will be given to FIDASC.
